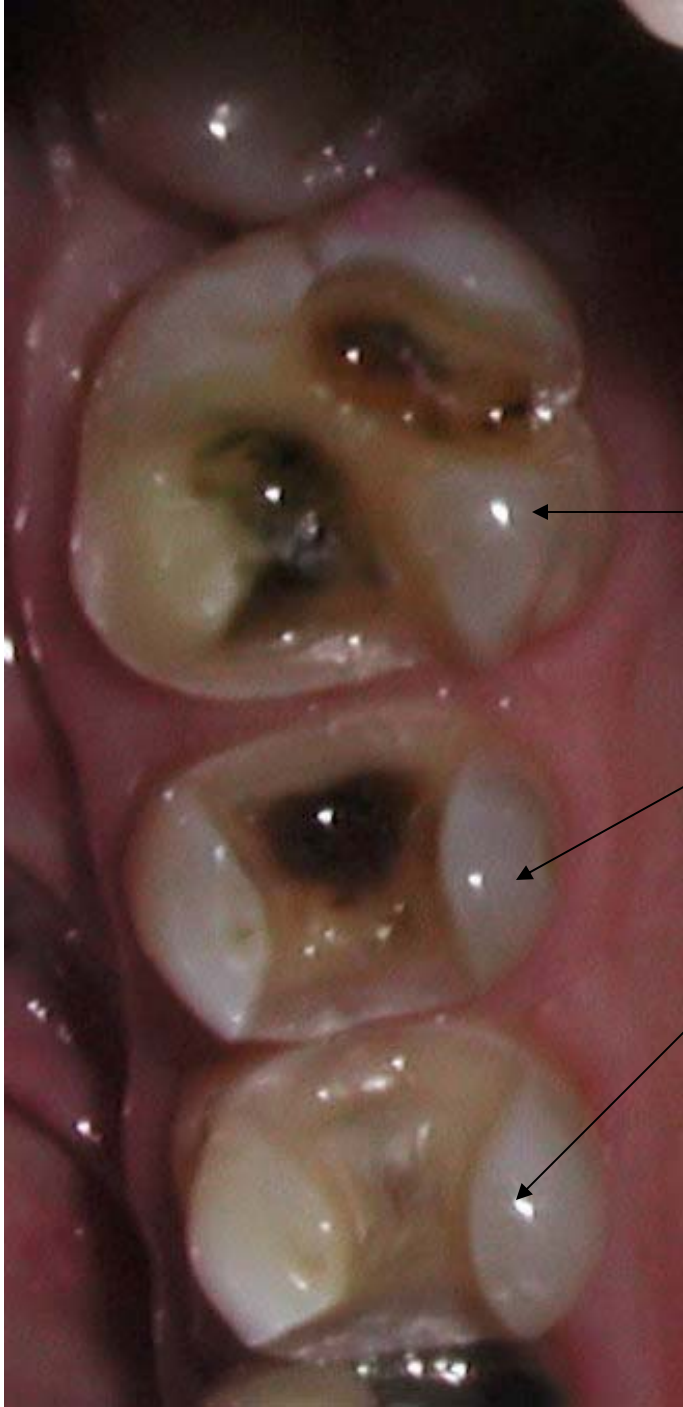




Deteriorated
